The Lenore F. Coral Travel Grant



The Lenore F. Coral Travel Grant, administered by the U.S. Branch of the International Association of Music Libraries, Archives and Documentation Centres (IAML), is intended to help support travel/conference fees to attend an annual meeting of IAML. Applicants for the award should have little or no support from their home institution or library. The grant is open to all members of the IAML-U.S. Branch, but priority will usually be given to people attending their first or second IAML conference who have not received this award in a previous year. The grant is a cash award in the amount of \$400.00. Applications should include a cover letter, a résumé, at least one letter of reference, and a proposed budget to be sent to Bonna Boettcher, Music Library/220 Lincoln Hall, Cornell University, Ithaca, NY 14853, or bjb57@cornell.edu, by 20 March 2009. A report (with original receipts attached) of how the grant money was expended is due within 90 days of the end of the IAML conference for which it was awarded.
